Active and Retired U.S. Military, including members of the U.S. Coast Guard and current members of the National Guard or Reserves, may purchase 4-Day Walt Disney World Armed Forces Salute Tickets for themselves and up to five (5) family members and/or friends.

Disney Military Promotional Tickets can be purchased by active and retired U.S. military personnel for themselves and up to five additional family members or friends. No more than six Disney Military Promotional Tickets may be purchased by any eligible member of the U.S. military (or spouse) pursuant to this offer.

All tickets and options are non-transferable and must be used by September 25, 2013 (certain blockout dates apply)
"Eligible Service Members" are active or retired members of the U.S. military, including the National Guard, Reservists and the U.S.
Coast Guard. "Salute" eligibility has in no way changed. DoD civilians and foreign military are not eligible for the "Salute".

The primary military member or their military ID-carrying spouse MUST be present for first usage of "Salute" tickets at both Walt Disney World and Disneyland. There has been conflicting info out there about this one especially relative to Disneyland Resort. This is a firm rule no matter what they are told elsewhere. We do not want to turn away Guests at our turnstiles, but if the primary military member or spouse is not present, we will not allow entry to the Parks. This "Salute" is for the military and their families to enjoy. These tickets may NOT be gifted to non-military personnel UNLESS the military personnel are traveling and enjoying the Parks with the non-military member.

A maximum of six per family will be enforced, and we will continue to capture info at activation allowing us to recognize those that have consumed the maximum allowed.

Each Disney Military Promotional Ticket must be used by the same person on any and all days. Disney Military Promotional Tickets may be used ONLY by the Eligible Service Members, spouses, other family members or friends for whom they are purchased. In addition, a valid military ID may be required for admission.

Disney Military Promotional Tickets (including any options) expire and may not be used after September 25, 2013. In addition, Disney 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets (including any options) for the Walt Disney World Resort may not be used on the following blockout dates:
